You should be a full-time student at your home university/ institution, that is we will ask for a certificate of enrollment at your home university/ institution. 2. Your home university/ institution and GCU should have an active exchange agreement. 3. Your university must nominate you. 4. Two letters of recommendation from your teachers at your home university/ institution are in need. 5. At GCU the language of instruction is English. Exchange students are expected to have a high level proficiency in English.
