Course Restriction	<p><u>Science Courses</u></p> <p>Science Exchange students will generally have priority in taking the following courses offered by the School of Science, subject to the course pre-requisites, class quota and approval of the course instructors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chemistry (CHEM) • Life Science (LIFS) • Mathematics (MATH) • Ocean Science (OCES) • Physics (PHYS) <p><u>Courses offered by other Schools</u></p> <p>Science Exchange students are allowed to take courses offered by other Schools, but this is subject to the course pre-requisite requirements, class quota and approval of the course instructors.</p>
Course Levels	Science exchange students are allowed to take postgraduate courses (i.e. course codes beginning with the digit ‘5’ or above) subject to the course pre-requisites, class quota and approval of the course instructors. Postgraduate courses for exchange students are limited since most are under the self-financed programs which are not open to exchange students.
Transcripts	Upon program completion, HKUST will produce transcripts in electronic format detailing the courses taken and the grades obtained. The transcripts will be sent to students and the home institution. For details, please refer to https://registry.hkust.edu.hk/transcript-grading .

Visa	<p>Students who do not have the right of abode or right to land and wish to study in Hong Kong are requires to obtain a valid student visa/ entry permit before coming to Hong Kong. Exchange students are NOT allowed to take up employment, whether paid or unpaid, during the studies in Hong Kong.</p> <p>HKUST Office of Global Learning will assist all exchange students in applying for Student Visa. The visa application procedures will be found in the admission package when you are successfully admitted to the Exchange Program. Application usually takes about 8 to 10 weeks after all documents are received. More information can be found at the website of the Hong Kong Immigration Department (http://www.immd.gov.hk).</p>	
Compulsory Insurance	<p>Students are required to subscribe to HKUST Compulsory Travel Insurance Plan that covers the duration of your study. The insurance fee is included in the UG exchange fee. On-Campus Health Services	<p>All registered students at HKUST are entitled to have complimentary medical consultation and medication at the on-campus clinic. However, please note that HKUST's health care service does not cover hospitalization.</p>	
Accommodation	<p>Undergraduate exchange students are provided with university housing available on and off-campus. To be eligible, you must indicate your intention to live on-campus on the HKUST application form. There are 9 on-campus halls and 1 off-campus hall for undergraduate students. Exchange students can choose between on-campus and off-campus accommodation and will be randomly assigned to a double room in one of these HKUST student halls. Students are not allowed to choose a specific hall or their roommates. You can find information about the student halls at Student Housing and Residential Life Office website.</p>	
Orientation	<p>A series of orientation activities for exchange students, such as cultural tours, workshops, etc., will be arranged by the Office of Global Learning. The School of Science will also hold an academic induction session exclusively for science exchange students.</p>
