**About HSE Saint Petersburg** Established in 1992, Higher School of Economics (HSE) is one of youngest and most dynamic Russian universities with teaching and research excellence in Economics, Management, Social Sciences and Humanities. HSE University is ranked #31 by QS Top50Under50 and #57 by THE among the young universities worldwide.

Since 2009, HSE bears the status of a 'National Research University', a mark of highest research impact and excellence in research-led education. Within the elite group of all 29 National Research Universities, HSE is the only institution of Economics, Social Sciences and Humanities core profile.

## Application Procedure

### Nomination

May 15 (Fall semester)

### Application deadlines for nominated students

October 15 (Spring semester)

June 1 (Fall semester)

*If students need to apply for a Russian visa, we strongly recommend to submit the application before the deadline.*

### Application form

Will be provided to the students after nomination deadline

### Supporting documents to be attached with the application

- Resumé / CV
- Recent Transcript of Records
- Motivation Letter
- Recommendation letter

### Minimum English language requirement

B2 level according to CEFRL.

*Although language certificates are not formally required, it is the responsibility of the home institution to ensure the fluency in English of the nominated students.*

### Do we accept students who do not meet the minimum English language requirement?

Yes, if they can take courses in the Russian language. The minimum level of Russian language proficiency is B2 according to CEFRL.

## Visa & Arrival

### VISA

Most exchange students will need a study visa to enter Russia. The International Office will apply for the electronic invitation letter for the student and send the copy by email. ### Airport pick-up service

## Study Plan

### Courses eligible for exchange students

All courses are open to exchange students, provided that the student complies with course prerequisites and language requirements. The list of courses in English can be found in HSE University Course Catalog (<https://www.hse.ru/en/edu/courses/>).

### Course selection & workload

The preliminary course selection is done before the start of each semester. The Incoming Mobility Coordinator will send a student the instruction on how to sign up for the preliminary chosen courses in the LMS system 4-10 weeks before the start of the semester.

*Exchange students normally take a workload of up to **30 ECTS** per semester.*

### Russian language course

HSE - Saint Petersburg offers all exchange students a one-semester-long intensive Russian language course (8 ECTS) free of charge. After the placement test during the orientation programme the students will be split into groups according to the level of language proficiency. ### Supporting documents required for the student dormitory

Upon check-in to the dormitory students are required to provide a general health certificate and a certification of a recent fluorographic chest/lungs X-Ray translated into Russian. Translation to Russian could be done upon arrival.
