Exchange Information

Application procedure:

The application process is through our online Student Mobility System. If your university has not received a user account and password to access the system, please contact us to ask for an account to be opened at: nvillanueva@global.unam.mx

The International Office will contact the nominated exchange students and provide all necessary information about the online application procedure. Your international office starts the nomination process on system by “Pre-registering” the nominated students; then the student will receive an e-mail notification with a link to complete application online and upload required documents. Your international office ends the process by reviewing, approving the application and uploading the institutional nomination letter on system; when this is completed, UNAM receives student’s application through the system as well.

Insurance:

Medical insurance is not available through our institution. It is mandatory for international students to obtain a Medical and Travel Insurance Policy before travelling to Mexico for studying at UNAM. It must be valid during the complete length of stay in Mexico and must cover major medical expenses, accidents, hospitalization, medical attention services at home in the case of disease, attention and or hospitalization for Covid-19 disease. Repatriation of mortal remains must be covered as well..

Practical information

Approximate living costs per month (USD)

Accommodation: \$150 to \$300 USD
Food: \$200 USD
Public transportation: \$40 USD
Study material: Varies depending on area of study.
Leisure and other expenses: \$80 to \$160.

Cost for Visiting Students outside of an agreement framework (USD)

Tuition fees: \$250 USD for one semester registration and \$275 USD for each subject / course taken. International travel, maintenance costs and medical insurance are to be paid by the student as well.
