Academic Information

Nomination	<p>Before you can register as an Erasmus student at the University of Bremen you have to be officially nominated by your home university. This nomination needs to include your name, course of studies, Erasmus Subject Area Code (according to the Bilateral Agreement between the universities), date of birth, planned duration of stay and your valid e-mail address.</p> <p>The deadline for nominations is: 31st of May (for winter term and whole academic year) 30th of November (for summer term)</p> <p>Please nominate to incoming@uni-bremen.de and to the Departmental Erasmus Coordinator http://www.uni-bremen.de/fileadmin/user_upload/international/EU-Programme/Erasmusbeauftragt.pdf</p>
Online application	<p>After we have received the nomination e-mail from your home university you will be invited to the online application procedure in June (for winter term) or in November (for summer term).</p> <p>The deadline for online applications: 30th of June (for winter term) 31st of December (for summer term)</p> <p>Required documents for application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - signed application form - enrolment certificate at home university - language certificates
Course Catalogue	<p>http://www.uni-bremen.de/en/studies/lecture-courses/course-catalogue.html</p> <p>The final version of the course list is usually published in August/September for the winter semester and in February/March for the summer semester.</p> <p>The main teaching language at the University of Bremen is German. The recommended German level to follow courses is B2 (according to the European language framework). There is a growing variety of courses offered in English in different departments. To view courses taught in English please select the respective field of studies and then click on the field at the top "English spoken only".</p>

Language Requirements	<p>German: B2 English (for English taught courses only): B2</p> <p>Please note: The main teaching language at the University of Bremen is German. Thus, most courses are taught in German. Please make sure that your German knowledge is sufficient to follow courses and lectures successfully. Language courses	<p>There is an optional intensive German language course during the orientation weeks organized by the Goethe Institut Bremen at the cost of 152 Euro (Jan 2017) for a three-weeks-course. Students will receive 6 ECTS upon successful participation (levels A1-B2). Admission only for registered Erasmus students who have participated in the online placement test sent by Goethe Institut after the end of the online registration period.</p> <p>Nominated Erasmus exchange students will get one German language course for 6 ECTS free of charge during the semester.</p> <p>You can also use the self-teaching facilities at our language center ("Fremdsprachenzentrum") or register for a tutorial programme there.</p>
